## Pilgrims' Days in the Diocese – St Patrick's Albury

### Day 1 Thursday 10<sup>th</sup> July

Pilgrims arrive in Albury and will be picked up from host parish



### Day 2 Friday 11<sup>th</sup> July

- 8.30am-9.00am **Travel** - Host families in Culcairn, Holbrook and Corowa to drop their pilgrims off at local Church for transportation to Albury  
(times may be adjusted slightly closer to July depending on coach companies)
- 8.45am onwards (earlier if need be due to host family work commitments)  
**Travel** - Pilgrims will be collected by coach from Corowa, Holbrook and Culcairn and taken in to St Patrick's Host families in Albury to drop off billets at St Patrick's Parish
- 10am **Deanery Mass** at St Patrick's Albury  
**Main celebrant:** Dean of Albury, Msgr Fulton  
**Concelebrating priests:** All other priests in Deanery should they be able too, and priests accompanying the international pilgrims  
**Liturgy:** readings and music to be undertaken by local young people (preferably our registered WYD08 pilgrims in the Albury Deanery)  
**Gift:** All visiting pilgrims will be presented with a gift by Deanery representatives (this should be done after Mass – can be done in the Church, or in the hall, and should be accompanied by a short speech from the representative presenting the gift to them).
- 12-1.00 pm **Lunch** for all pilgrims in the St Patrick's Hall
- 1.00 pm **Travel** - Culcairn, Holbrook and Corowa hosted pilgrims will be picked up by coach and returned to their host Shire Council areas

- 1.30 pm **Travel** - Albury billeted pilgrims will walk from St Patrick's Hall, lead by local young people, to site of Civic Reception (likely to be at Civic Centre but not yet confirmed)
- 2pm **Civic reception** – Albury City Council  
- Corowa Shire Council  
- Greater Hume Shire Council
- 3.00 aprox **Travel** - Pilgrims will be lead from Civic Reception (in groups of 10) by local young people, to Service Project Venues
- 3.30pm **Service projects** - International pilgrims and local young people will take part in service projects at local community and welfare venues.
- 5.30pm **Travel** - Culcairn, Holbrook and Corowa pilgrims will be lead by their local young person back to coach and will be transported back to St Patrick's for the pilgrim dinner<sup>1</sup>
- 6pm **Travel** - Albury pilgrims will return to St Patrick's Hall
- 6.30pm **Dinner** at St Patrick's Hall.
- 8.30pm **Travel** - Corowa, Culcairn and Holbrook will be picked up by coaches and return to host parishes.



### **Day 3      Saturday 12<sup>th</sup> July**

- Morning with Host Families including lunch
- 1.00 pm **Travel** - Host families to drop billets off at their parish Church
- 2pm **Tours** - Pilgrims will be picked up by coaches and taken on tours to local sites of interest – (will be organized by local Tourist Information Centre)
- 6pm **Travel** - Pilgrims will be dropped off at Lavington, by coaches, from outlying areas Deanery Mass at Holy Spirit Lavington

**Main celebrant:** visiting international priest  
**Concelebrating priests:** international priests Deanery Activity,  
 Holy Spirit Hall
- 7.45 **Social activity**  
**Venue:** Holy Spirit Hall, Lavington  
**Event:** Bush dance
- 9.30 pm **Travel** - Corowa, Culcairn and Holbrook will be picked up by coaches and return to host parishes.
- 10.00pm- **Travel** - Host families to pick up billets Albury host 10.30 families to pick up from Holy Spirit Hall.  
 Corowa, Culcairn and Holbrook host families to pick up from their parish Church.



#### **DAY 4: Sunday 13 July PARISH DAY**

- 9am **Parish Mass** involving pilgrims from Austria and St Patrick's Parish
- 10am **Legacy** - Group Photo our pilgrims with International pilgrims and Legacy activity
- 12pm **Parish Lunch** followed by a Parish activity
- 6pm **Farewell Dinner** in St Patrick's Hall including: Host families, international pilgrims, St Pats pilgrims and DID Team



#### **Day 5: Monday 14<sup>th</sup> July**

After morning Mass, International and St Patrick's wyd pilgrims depart for Sydney.
